Bendi Card Basics

Cardstock: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2"

1. Cut in half at 4-1/4"
2. Set one half aside
3. Score one in landscape: 1/2"
4. Turn to portrait and cut at 2-1/2"
5. Mark 1/4" on one end of each strip and cut tab as shown in the video (link below)
6. On the 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" piece
 - draw a line at 4"
 - Lay larger strip across, bottom edge flush and mark either side of the tab along the 4" line.
 - Cut the slit for the tab
7. On the 2-1/2 x 5-1/2" strip
 - Draw a line 2" from the score line
 - Lay smaller strip across the larger strip with bottom edges flush and mark either side of the tab.
 - Cut a slit for the tab
8. Use In The Woods Framelit to cut a gentle curve on each strip
OR freehand the curve and fussy cut
 - If adding designer paper to each strip:
 - 2-1/4" x 4-1/2"
 - 1-1/2" x 4-1/2"
9. Adhere tabs on strips to back of the base with Tear and Tape.
10. Embellish card as desired.
