Double Diamond Fold Card Basics



Card Stock:

Card Base: 5-1/2" x 11"

- Score in Landscape: 2-3/4", 4-1/4", 6-3/4", 8-1/4"
- Tic in Landscape: 1-3/8" from each end, top and bottom
- Tic in Portrait: 2-3/4" top and bottom

Center and Back Panels: 2-3/8" x 5-5/16" (2) Basic White or Very Vanilla

Designer Paper:

Diamonds: (2) 2-5/8" x 5-3/8"

- Tic in Landscape: 1-5/16"
- Tic in Portrait: 2-11/16"

Small Triangles 2-3/4" x 5-1/8"

Directions:

1. With the card base in your Paper Trimmer, score diagonals as shown in the video from the Landscape tic marks to the score lines. You'll score 4 diagonal lines.
2. Place the two sets of tic marks in the track of your trimmer and cut a diagonal. Repeat for the other three sets of tic marks.
3. To cut the diamonds from your designer paper, place one portrait and one landscape tic mark in the track of your Paper Trimmer and cut. Repeat for the remaining three cuts.
4. To cut the smaller triangles: place the remaining piece of designer paper in your Paper Trimmer with two opposite corner points in the track and cut corner to corner. Hold the designer paper pieces together and rotate so the other set of corner points are in the track and cut.
5. Place the flat edge of one of the smaller triangles at the top of the Paper Trimmer with the point in the track and cut in half. Repeat for the other smaller triangle.
6. Place each small triangle formed from the last cut in the Paper Trimmer with the straight edge at the top and the straight end at 1/8" to the right of the track and cut.
7. Check the fit of the designer paper diamonds, trim the inside edge with your Paper Snips if necessary and adhere to the far right and left sections with Multipurpose Glue.
8. Check the fit of the smallest triangles and trim with your Paper Snips if necessary. Adhere two on each side of the center panel using Multipurpose Glue.
9. Check the fit of the largest designer paper triangles, trim with your Paper Snips if necessary and adhere with Multipurpose Glue.
10. Adhere the Basic White panels to the center front and back of the card with Multipurpose Glue.
11. Decorate with stamped images.

TIP: Use a non-directional designer paper pattern for the triangles on this card.
