Musical Season Favors



Supplies:

Merry Music designer paper
Real Red cardstock
Garden Green cardstock
Multipurpose Adhesive

Tools:

Musical Instruments Framelits
Pretty Pines Thinlits
Big Shot
Die Brush
Stampin' Trimmer

Cut Garden Green cardstock to 5-1/2" x 8-1/2".

Cut pine boughs from Garden Green cardstock – you'll get 10 pairs from each 1/2 sheet.

Cut Real Red cardstock to 3" x 3" for each French horn.

For your convenience, simply click the supply items and tools to be taken to the store.

Use the Die Brush to help you easily remove both the chads and the delicate die cuts.

Cut Merry Music designer paper to 3" x 6".

With the paper in landscape orientation, make sure that the design on the front of the packet will be right side up when folded, then score ½" from the top.

Score another line at 3-1/4".

Fold the ½" score line down.

Bring the other end up and tuck it under the ½" flap without giving the bottom scoreline a hard crease.

Adhere the larger pine bough to the packet.

Add glue to the bottom half of the French horn.

Place the French horn so that it overlaps the ½" flap.

The ½" flap will tuck behind the French horn and hold the favor closed.

Adhere the smaller pine bough over the French horn.

Finish by using a Glue Dot to secure the treat to the inside of the favor.
