## Moose Christmas Ornament

- Trace the box onto the Feels Like Frost designer paper. Cut out with your Paper Snips. You will need to trim it slightly to fit.
- Cut the snow mounds from Purples Posy with an In the Woods Die and emboss a Wrapped In Texture Embossing Folder. Use the edge of the designer paper liner as a guide to help shape the bottom edge of the snow mounds.
- Cut 4 Basic Gray trees with In the Woods Dies. Adhere to each other in stacks of two.

- Use your Take Your Pick Tool to poke a hole in the top.
- Adhere the Feels Like Frost liner.
- Adhere the trees and 1 snow mound with Multipurpose Glue. Adhere the second snow mound with Dimensionals.
- Designer Paper strip for the outside – adhere with Multipurpose Glue.
  - 15/16" x 11"
  - 15/16" x 3-13/16"
- Feed 8" of Whisper White Silver Metallic Edge Ribbon through the hole to form a loop. Adhere with hot glue.
- Designer Paper strip for the inside – adhere with Multipurpose Glue
  - 13/16" x 11"
  - 13/16" x 3-1/16"
- Cut 3 Blackberry Bliss moose with the Moose Punch. Sandwich in a slightly offset stack using Black Stampin' Dimensionals. Then adhere with Multipurpose Glue.
- Cut four sets of leaves from Silver Foil Sheet using an In the Woods Die. Cut 2 more sets of leaves from the white side of the foil sheet. Adhere these last 2 sets to two of the sets cut from the foil side using Multipurpose Glue. Adhere the non-layered sets of leaves, one on either side of the ribbon loop towards the back. Then adhere the remaining two sets on either side of the loop slightly overhanging the front of the ornament.

Sizes for the designer paper strips will vary slightly when creating an ornament from the lid versus the base of the box.
