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## Diamond Point Card Basics And Modified Diamond Point Card Basics



### **6" x 6" Diamond Point Fold**

#### **Card Stock:**

6" x 12" scored and folded to 6" x 6"

5-3/4" x 5-3/4" Basic White or Very Vanilla (if using a colored card base)

#### **Designer Paper:**

5-3/4" x 5-3/4"

#### **Directions:**

1. Put the narrow side of one end of the card base in your Paper Trimmer at 3".
2. Lightly score a tic mark.
3. Rotate the card base so that the tic mark and the right-hand edge of the score line are in the track. Cut from tic mark to score line. Repeat for the left side. You'll have (2) triangular pieces.
4. Put the designer paper in your Paper Trimmer at 2-7/8" and lightly score a tic mark. Rotate the designer paper so that the tic mark and the right-hand bottom edge are in the track. Cut from tic mark to edge. Repeat for left hand side. **Tip:** Start the cut a little in from the bottom or top of the designer paper and move out to the edges. This will keep you from bending the end points.
5. Adhere designer paper to cardstock triangles with Multipurpose Glue.
6. Adhere the smaller triangles to the card base with Dimensionals.
7. Finish/Embellish as desired.

### **5" x 5" Diamond Point Fold**

#### **Card Stock:**

5" x 10" scored and folded to 5" x 5"

4-3/4" x 4-3/4" Basic White or Very Vanilla (if using a colored card base)

#### **Designer Paper:**

4-3/4" x 4-3/4"

#### **Directions:**

1. Put the narrow side of one end of the card base in your Paper Trimmer at 2-1/2".
2. Lightly score a tic mark.



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3. Rotate the card base so that the tic mark and the right-hand edge of the score line are in the track. Cut from tic mark to score line. Repeat for the left side. You'll have (2) triangular pieces.
4. Put the designer paper in your Paper Trimmer at 2-3/8" and lightly score a tic mark. Rotate the designer paper so that the tic mark and the right-hand bottom edge are in the track. Cut from tic mark to edge. Repeat for left hand side. **Tip:** Start the cut a little in from the bottom or top of the designer paper and move out to the edges. This will keep you from bending the end points.
5. Adhere designer paper to cardstock triangles with Multipurpose Glue.
6. Adhere the smaller triangles to the card base with Dimensionals.
7. Finish/Embellish as desired.

### Modified Diamond Point Card

#### Cardstock:

4-1/4" x 11" scored and folded to 4-1/4" x 5-1/2"  
4-1/4" x 5-1/2" to match card base  
4" x 5-1/4" Basic White

#### Designer Paper:

(2) 4" x 5-1/4"

#### Directions:

1. Place one narrow end of your scored card base in your Paper Trimmer at 2-1/8" t and lightly score a tic mark
2. With the tic mark in the track, turn the card base so that the right-hand corner of the score line is in the track. Cut the diagonal piece. Repeat, turning the card base to line up the tic mark and left-hand corner of the score line.
3. Place the narrow end of one piece of designer paper in your Paper Trimmer at 2" and score to add a light tic mark. With the tic mark in the track line of the right-hand corner in the track and cut. Repeat lining up for the left corner and cut.
4. Adhere the largest triangular piece to the pointed part of the card base with Multipurpose Glue.
5. Adhere the two designer paper triangles to the cardstock triangles with Multipurpose Glue.
6. Adhere the remaining piece of designer paper to the piece of cardstock that matches the card base.
7. Use your Paper Trimmer to trim 1/16" or 2mm from the top of the layered panel.



8. Adhere the panel to the back of the pointed portion of the card base with Multipurpose Glue. **Tip:** Make sure the bottom and two sides the panel are flush with the bottom and side edges of the card base before pressing to adhere.
9. Cross the two smaller triangles and add them to the card front with Dimensionals.
10. Finish and embellish as desired.

**TIP: Use a non-directional designer paper pattern for the piece you will cut into triangles.**
